

## INVITATION FOR BIDS

CDBG # Grant 08-DB-D3-10-60-01-A07

This project is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development through the Florida Department of Community Affairs under the 2005 Disaster Recovery Institute Program – Supplemental Appropriation (Grant # 08DB-D3-10-60-01-A07). The successful bidder shall comply with all provisions contained in these bid documents entitled “Requirements for Federally Funded Projects”. This Bid contains the Davis-Bacon wage decision which is applicable to this project.

The West Palm Beach Housing Authority is requesting bids from licensed general contractors to remove and install hurricane impact windows and doors in one hundred and twenty (120) units at its Twin Lakes Development and to remove and install hurricane resistant windows and doors in forty-four (44) units and replace 11 rooftops at its Colony Oaks Development. This project is being funded by CDBG Grant # 08DB-D3-10-60-01-A07

The Contractor shall be responsible for all labor, equipment, materials and supplies necessary in accordance with plans and specifications, and in a condition acceptable to the West Palm Beach Housing Authority.

Plans and specifications will be available beginning **Wednesday, April 7, 2010** at 1715 Division Avenue, West Palm Beach, Florida. A \$25 fee (check or money order only) will be required to pick up plans and specifications. This fee will be waived for prior bidders.

**All bids must be accompanied by a bid guarantee which shall not be less than 5% of the bid amount.**

**A Pre-bid meeting to tour the job site will be held on Monday, April 26, 2010 at 10:00 A.M. and prospective bidders should meet at 1715 Division Avenue, West Palm Beach.** Bid packages, plans, and scope of work will also be available at that time.

**Bids must be received, either by hand delivery or mail, at the West Palm Beach Housing Authority, 1715 Division Avenue, West Palm Beach Florida 33407, by 10:00 A.M. Wednesday, May 12, 2010. No faxed or electronic submittals will be accepted. Bids will be opened on the same date at 10:15 A.M.** at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Board Room of the West Palm Beach Housing Authority, 1715 Division Avenue.

The West Palm Beach Housing Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in the bidding. Bids may be held by the West Palm Beach Housing Authority for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date the bidders, prior to awarding the contract of opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing them and investigating the qualifications of the bidders prior to awarding the contract.
